



## 2006 HALL "BERGFELD" CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Deeply hued, our 2006 "Bergfeld" brims with voluminous aromas of jammy blackberry, roasted espresso, fennel, and black currant. The sweet mid-palate overflows with ripened plum and cassis, concluding with a warm, spicy oak finish. Such a massively structured wine begged additional aging in our cellar. Upon release it is broad and muscular and is best decanted. The 2006 "Bergfeld" will gain richness and complexity over the next 10 - 12 years.
