



2007 HALL "JACK'S MASTERPIECE" CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Each year, HALL's former winemaker and current president, Mike Reynolds, returns to his first love and blends a signature Cabernet Sauvignon known as "Jack's Masterpiece." The wine is named for the label artwork created by Mike's then 18-month-old son Jack as a Father's Day gift.

The deep, dark ruby 2007 vintage leads with inviting blackberry pie, black currant and toasted coconut aromas with densely packed dark plum, cola and black spice flavors captivating the palate. The delectably rich structure is focused and lasting. Allow 5-8 years for this wine to hit its peak.
